July 15, 2014 Joint Meeting

The meeting was called to order and introductions were made. Staff and Consultants made a powerpoint presentation covering the relationship of the Parks and Recreation Master Plan to the General Plan, the organization and function of the Parks and Recreation Department, and the purpose, organization, and factors that influence a Parks and Recreation Master Plan.
